Reservations and a \$25.00 deposit per person must be received by **July 18, 2018**. Balance is due upon registration at camp. No refunds after July 18. Registrations after July 18 will be assessed a \$10 per person late fee. Hay is available for \$6.00 per bale. Quantity needed must be indicated on registration form. **No reservations will be accepted after July 25, 2018.**

We have a limited number of wooded and open camping areas with electric hookups. Call or email to find out what is available. Electric is \$15 per day for members and \$25 per day for non-members (Charged for Fri. & Sat. only).

Generators may be used in the open field or primitive camping sites. Water is plentiful including showers. Breakfast, lunch and dinner provided.

Important reminder: If you are staying on our clubgrounds, riding or not riding, you must register and pay full price as listed. Children must be accompanied by an adult. All campers and riders must be registered and paid in full. Non-member rate includes a \$1 Event Membership Fee.

Ride at your own risk. The Greater Johnstown Saddle Club is not responsible for any accidents that may occur. Please note: there is no phone at the clubgrounds. Local law enforcement is the Adams Township Police Dept. Non-emergency number is 814-472-2100

RULES *The following rules will be enforced to ensure a safe and pleasant weekend for everyone.*

- Dogs must be tied or leashed and under control at all times. They are not permitted in the kitchen or pavilion. Clean up after your pet. Correct excessive barking.
- Horseback riders may only leave the grounds on scheduled rides. We don't want anyone ending up in areas that are off limits.
- Obey the trail boss at all times. Do not pass up the trail boss when riding. If you have any problems during the trail ride let the trail boss know.
- Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
- Quiet time is from 12 midnight to 6:00 am
- Vulgarity will not be tolerated
- Do not tie horses directly to trees where they may chew the bark
- No cowboying or excessive horseplay allowed. This includes racing or running on the trails.
- Mark horses known to kick with a red ribbon on the tail.
- No unattended animals are to be in the show ring.
- Due to insurance issues, NO alcohol is permitted on the trails.
- All participants must have their ID bands to eat and ride all weekend.
