Registrations after July 17 will be assessed a \$10 per person late fee. Hay is available for \$6.00 per bale. Indicate quantity needed on registration form.

No reservations accepted after July 24, 2020.

We have a limited number of wooded and open camping areas with electric hookups. Call or email to find out what is available. Electric is \$15 per day for members. For non-members, \$25 per day (Friday or Saturday) or \$40 for the weekend.

Generators may be used in the open field or primitive camping sites. Water is plentiful including showers. Breakfast, lunch and dinner provided.

Important reminder: If you are staying on our club grounds, riding or not riding, you must register and pay full price as listed. Children must be accompanied by an adult. All campers and riders must be registered and paid in full. Non-member rate includes a \$1 Event Membership Fee.

RULES



The following rules will be enforced to ensure a safe and pleasant weekend for everyone.

- Dogs must be tied or leashed and under control at all times. They are not permitted in the kitchen or pavilion. Clean up after your pet. Correct excessive barking.
- Horseback riders may only leave the grounds on scheduled rides. We don't want anyone riding in off limit areas.
- Obey the trail boss at all times. Do not pass up the trail boss when riding. If you have any problems during the trail ride let the trail boss know.
- Firearms and fireworks are not permitted.
- Quiet time is from 12 midnight to 6:00 am.
- Vulgarity will not be tolerated.
- Do not tie horses directly to trees where they chew the bark
- Portable corrals are OK as long as the horse is used to being kept in it and the size is kept to a minimum and does not infringe on other camping areas.
- No cowboying or excessive horseplay allowed. This includes racing or running on the trails.
- Mark horses known to kick with a red ribbon on the tail.
- No unattended animals are to be in the show ring.
- Due to insurance issues, NO alcohol is permitted on the trails.
